Freedom Activity Camp

The Camps

Freedom Activity Camps are held at Grainville School, during both weeks of the Easter holidays and during the first five weeks of the Summer holidays every year.

Cost

The cost from (8:30am to 5:00pm) is £190 per 5 day week, £150 for the 4 day weeks during the Easter break. You may also book either morning sessions (8:30am to 12:30pm) or afternoon sessions (1pm to 5pm) at a cost of £100 per week. The cost for the 4 day week with the bank holiday is £80 per morning or afternoon session .

The Activities



During the morning and an afternoon session the children will be able to select their activities for each session every day. Friendship groups can stay together and choices can be changed as often as they wish. We offer a mixtures of activities such as a variety of sport based activities, art/craft/pottery, dance, drama, lego building, wall climbing, slime making, tug of war and even water play when weather permits... There will also be opportunities for free play every day,

Health & Covid

We comply with all of the Government regulations regarding Covid and we are inspected by CEYS, from the Education Department.

The Timetable

Each day begins at 8:30am and finishes at 5:00pm with a break for lunch at 12:00. Participants may be dropped off from 8:30, will have access to a variety of games and playground equipment and will be fully supervised until the morning activities commence at 9:00am.

Weather

In the event of rain we may have to replace some of the outside activities with the option of inside games. This will only be done if it becomes necessary and children will revert to their outside choices when the weather permits.



The Staff

The staff are all teachers, childcare workers, qualified coaches or students specifically chosen for their knowledge of a particular sport or activity and their understanding of the needs and requirements of young children in these situations. All staff are police checked and child protection trained. We aim to maintain a ratio of 8:1 in all of our groups.

Children: What you need



You need to wear suitable clothing for your chosen activity, a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks please), and plenty of energy and enthusiasm. There is no need to bring your own equipment, (tennis racquets etc.) all the necessary equipment will be provided. Please do not bring valuables or money; we cannot be responsible for their security and there is

nowhere to spend money. NO NUTS, we often have children with serious nut allergies and we must keep them safe.

Booking

In order to secure a place a completed application form and a deposit of £50 per child is required with the balance to be paid on the first day of each camp. If you are downloading an application form,

please be sure to tick the dates and sessions that you require. Fees may be paid by PAYPAL (to jimwestwater@icloud.com) if desired or to the bank account noted below. The cost covers all tuition, supervision and the use of all equipment and facilities. A 10% discount is now given when one more children from the same family attend together or where a child already attends one of Freedom's After School Clubs

Cancellation

If for any reason, we cancel any camps, all money paid will be refunded in full.

Participants

Boys and girls from reception age to 12 are welcome to come along and take part in the activities. Younger children are monitored very carefully and if it is felt that any children are having difficulty coping within the main group, they will be offered a place in a smaller group continuing with less rigorous activities. Parents will be informed if this affects their children and further, any parents who feel this may be the most appropriate option for their children should speak with the manager. There is no extra cost for this option.

Terms and conditions

Data Protection

The information collected on this form will be held by Freedom Activity Camp in manual and in electronic format. The information will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018. The purpose of holding this information is to facilitate your child's participation with Freedom Activity Camp. Disclosure of any of this information to statutory bodies such as the Department for Education or its agencies will take place only in accordance with legislation or regulatory requirements. Explicit consent will be sought from Parents/Guardians if Freedom Activity Camp wishes to disclose this information to a third party for any other reason.

Registration of Camp

Freedom Activity Camp is a registered play care provider and parents may be able to claim a tax allowance for the fees paid to us for all of our activity camps.

Exclusion after sickness

If your child is unwell at home with sickness and/or diarrhea, they should be kept at home for **a minimum of 48 hours following the last episode of illness**. If they are sick and/or have diarrhea at the club, there must be a minimum period of 48 hours following the last episode before they return to the club.

Signing out

Each child must be signed out at the end of each session, by a member of *our* staff. Please make sure that you have signed your child out before you take them home.

Social Media/Photography

During sessions, we may take photograhs of the children whilst they are engaged in their activities. These photographs or video clips may be used on our website or on our Facebook page. If you do not want your child' image to be used in this way, please indicate by noting "do not give" to the relevant question on the registration form.

Booking

Each booking must be accompanied by a non refundable deposit of £50 per child. if you wish, you may pay the whole fee at the time of booking. Fees can be paid weekly at the beginning of the week booked. Cancellation prior to seven days in advance of the first day of the booked week will incur no penalty and any money paid other than the deposit will be refunded. Cancellation after seven days or a no show will be charged the full amount due for the time booked.
